### **1.3 Ratification of the Chair**

Whereas the Chairperson of the Board of Administration shall be responsible for maintaining order at meetings and;

Whereas as per article 3.1.11.1 The Executive shall appoint the Chairperson of the Board of Administration, and the appointment shall be confirmed by a simple majority vote of votes cast by the directors of the Board of Administration present at a meeting.

*Be it resolved that* Bilan Arte be confirmed as Chairperson for the 2017-2018 SFUO Board of Administration year

### **1.11 Ratification of the Comptroller General**

Whereas defined in article 7.1 the board of administration shall appoint yearly an officer not exercising any other function for the Federation and named Comptroller General.

Whereas the appointment for the comptroller general must be by a majority vote of the board of administration.

*Be it resolved that* the 2017-2018 SFUO Board of Administration appoint Yannick Mugabo as the Comptroller General.

### **1.12 Motion *Our Turn Initiative***

Whereas rape culture and sexual violence are prevalent at the University of Ottawa

Whereas the current University of Ottawa policy, passed June 2016 was implemented with little student representation and has yet to meet for the one (1) year review of said policy.

Whereas student consultation and student led initiatives are very important to enacting progressive policies and practices for our communities.

Whereas sexual violence is not over after Bill 168 and student organizers at Carleton University have created the now National Our Turn project where they have step by step guides to help student unions on campus address sexual violence while also publishing a report card grading all Ontario Universities on their sexual assault policies.

Whereas we must still be actively engaging as student leaders to make our campus safe especially for those most vulnerable to violence

*Be it resolved that* the SFUO implement the Our Turn initiative and create an intersectional



student task force chaired by the Vice President Equity

*Be it further resolved that the SFUO create a campus wide sexual violence survey to be distributed and completed by the Undergraduate student population by December 2017.*

### **1.13 First Reading: 101 Week Bracelet Cutting**

WHEREAS Bylaw 10 stipulates rules and regulation concerning 101 Week.

*BE IT RESOLVED* that article 10.7.8.3 be added to the SFUO Constitution to read:

“All positions defined in 10.7.8.1, who have bracelet-cutting authority must receive a Bracelet Cutting Training by the SFUO VP Social or President no later than seven (7) days prior to 101 Week. Should any of the defined individuals not complete the Bracelet Cutting Training, they may not have bracelet-cutting authority during 101 Week.”

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED* that article 10.7.8.4 be added to the SFUO Constitution to read:

“In the instance that a bracelet is cut during 101 Week, the penalties are as follows:

- a. for a 101er: they may no longer participate for the remainder of 101 Week, but may participate in future 101 Weeks as a Guide once completing guide trainings.
- b. for a Guide: they may no longer participate for the remainder of 101 Week and in future 101 Weeks.
- c. for a Federated Body Executive, Safety Ambassador, and/or 101 Crew Member: they may no longer participate for the remainder of 101 Week and future 101 Weeks. These members may also not be eligible to run for SFUO or Federated Body elections pending the decision of the 101 Council.
- d. for a UOSERT Member, penalties shall be the at the discretion of the UOSERT Advisory Board.
- e. The 101 Council may add disciplinary measures to the above-mentioned penalties but may not reduce.”

### **1.14 First Reading: Take Back The Night**

Whereas the SFUO constitution outlines Take Back the Night as a mandatory event 10.2.2.2

Whereas the SFUO has witnessed, many fed bodies excuse themselves from the event despite this clause throughout the years

Whereas the SFUO and the University of Ottawa are taking a much more involved and direct

approach to tackling rape culture and sexual violence prevention on this campus

*Be it resolved that section 10.2.2.5 read* Federated bodies and other groups approved by the SFUO may not schedule events that would conflict with the mandatory events listed in 10.2.2.2 and must ensure that any other events during their 101-week schedule do not prevent the maximum number of students from participating in the mandatory events. Fed bodies that fail to do this will subject themselves to a 25% penalty on their levies at the discretion of the VP Equity, VP Social and the VP Finance.

*Be it resolved that section 10.2.2.4 read* Federated bodies and other groups that are approved by the social roundtable organizing their own 101 Week shall participate in these four events.

## **1.15 101 Guide Training Program**

WHEREAS Bylaw 10 stipulates rules and regulation concerning 101 Week.

10.5.3.2.1 Notwithstanding paragraph 10.2.2.2, OPIRG will have a special training for guides participating in 101 Week.

*BE IT RESOLVED* that article 10.5.3.2.1 be removed from the SFUO Constitution:

“Notwithstanding paragraph 10.2.2.2, OPIRG will have a special training for guides participating in 101 Week.”

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED* that article 10.5.3.6 be modified in the SFUO Constitution to read:

“The 101 Guide training program shall incorporate an anti-oppression training program approved by the Vice-President, Equity of the SFUO.”

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED* that article 10.5.3.8 be added to the SFUO Constitution to read:

“The 101 Guide Training program shall incorporate a minimum of a sixty (60) minute training on sexual violence prevention approved and provided by the Vice-President, Equity of the SFUO and/or a designate.”

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED* that article 10.5.3.9 be added to the SFUO Constitution to read:

“The 101 Guide Training program shall incorporate a minimum of a sixty (90) minute presentation of the rules and regulations of Bylaw 10 approved and provided by the Volunteer of Coordinator of the SFUO; the Vice-President, Social of the SFUO; and/or a designate.”

The Chairperson of the Board of Administration of the Federation shall, upon receipt of the written notice of appeal, send to the members of the Board of Administration a copy of the judgement and a notice to discuss the appeal at a meeting.”

### **1.17 First Reading: Functions of the Social Roundtable and Safety Ambassadors**

WHEREAS Bylaw 10 stipulates rules and regulation concerning 101 Week.

*BE IT RESOLVED* that article 3.12.7.1 (d) be removed from the SFUO Constitution:

“Functions of the Social Roundtable: d. To recruit and oversee the work of the Safety Ambassadors during 101 Week as defined in Article 10.3.1.”
